Probability Questions with Solutions

Solution: a) Standard probability definition
Let a random event meet following conditions: number of the events is finite; all events have the same chance to occur; no two events can occur in the same time;
Probability of an event A equals $\frac{m}{n}$, $n = \#$ of all possible events, $m =$ number of cases favorable for the event A
Stands: $0 \leq P(A) \leq 1$

Solution: The probability to get the first ball is red or the first event is $5/20$. Now, since we have drawn a ball for the first event to occur, then the number of possibilities left for the second event to occur is $20 - 1 = 19$. Hence,

the probability of getting the second ball as blue or the second event is $4/19$.

The probability of an event occurring given that another event has already occurred is called a conditional probability. Recall that when two events, A and B, are dependent, the probability of both occurring is: $P(A \text{ and } B) = P(A) \times P(B \text{ given } A)$ or $P(A \text{ and } B) = P$
