The Lipids Triglycerides Phospholipids And

Triglycerides and phospholipids are two groups of lipids A condensation reaction (removal of water) between a glycerol molecule and fatty acid forms an ester bond Hydrolysis, addition of a water molecule, of a triglyceride form fatty acids and glycerol.

Phospholipid Synthesis | Biology

Triglycerides and phospholipids are both lipids. Triglycerides are made from glycerol and three fatty acids, while phospholipids are made from glycerol, two fatty acids and phosphorus. Because of their differing structures, these lipids also differ in function.

Difference Between Triglycerides & Phospholipids | Sciencing

Lipid Transport Low Density Lipoprotein (LDL) Composed primarily of cholesterol Circulate throughout the body and release triglyceride, cholesterol and phospholipid to body cells. Body cells collect the lipids and use them to make cell membranes, hormones, or store for later use. Liver removes LDL from circulation

Lipids include a diverse group of water insoluble biomolecules that are mainly nonpolar in nature. 3 main types of lipids include: Triglycerides; Phospholipids; Steroids; Different types of lipids have a variety of biological roles. The main function of triglycerides is similar to carbohydrates.

Structures and 3 main functions of lipids: triglycerides ...

A typical lipoprotein contains an interior of triglycerides and cholesterol surrounded by phospholipids. The phospholipids' fatty acid "tails" point towards the interior, where the lipids are. Proteins near the outer ends of the phospholipids cover the structure.

The Lipids: Triglycerides, Phospholipids and Sterols

Phospholipids. Phospholipids are essentially the same as triglycerides in

that they consist of a glycerol molecule bonded to fatty acid molecules in condensation reactions. The one difference is that the third hydroxyl group of the glycerol molecule is bonded to a phosphate group instead.

- Triglycerides are more abundant than phospholipids.
- Triglycerides are soluble only in fat, whereas phospholipids are soluble in both water and fat.
- Triglyceride molecule contains three fatty acid chains, whereas phospholipid molecule contains two fatty acids plus one phosphate group.
