"Les Belles Soeurs" by Michel Tremblay: Translated by Bill Glassco and John Van Burek

In 1965, Michel Tremblay wrote what is generally acknowledged to be his greatest work, *Les Belles Soeurs*. The play received widespread acclaim (and violent opposition) in the province of Quebec, and set the criteria for a new Quebecois canon of literature before going on to be translated into various languages and dialects and performed in over twenty different countries. It was performed for the first time in English at Toronto's St. Lawrence Centre for the Performing Arts, and received widespread critical acclaim. It is interesting to note, however, that the

reviews of the English-language performance of the play focused on significantly different aspects of the play than did those of the original Montreal performance, a shift that can be attributed to both cultural differences and a translation which removed many of the references to specifically Quebecois cultural aspects. The purpose of this edition, then, is to situate the play in the social, political, economic, and theatrical contexts that surround it, and to provide the reader with a deeper appreciation of perhaps the most widely produced play in Canadian history. In order to do this, the edition draws on a wide body of critical literature on *Les Belles Soeurs* itself as well as historical, sociological, and political writings. It also draws heavily on dramatic theory,

reviews, and criticism of the play, in order to provide the reader with the most fully contextualized version of *Les Belles Soeurs* to date.

In *National Performance*, Erin Hurley examines the complex relationship between performance and national identity. How do theatrical performances represent the nation in which they were created? How is Quebecois performance used to define Quebec as a nation and to cultivate a sense of 'Quebec-ness' for audiences both within and outside the province? In exploring Expo 67, the critical response to Michel Tremblay's *Les Belles Soeurs*, Carbone 14's image-theatre, Marco Micone's writing practices, Celine Dion's popular music, and feminist performance of the 1970s and 80s, Hurley reveals the ways in which certain performances come to be understood as 'national' while others are

relegated to sub-national or outsider status. Each chapter focuses on a particular historical moment in Quebec's modern history and a genre of performance emblematic of the moment, and uses these to elaborate the nature of the national performances. Winner of the Northeast Modern Language Association's Book Prize, *National Performance* is sophisticated yet accessible, seeking to enlarge the parameters of what counts as 'Quebecois' performance, while providing a thorough introduction to changing discourses of nation-ness in Quebec.

Translation is tricky business. The translator has to transform the foreign to

the familiar while moving and pleasing his or her audience. Louise Ladouceur knows theatre from a multi-dimensional perspective that gives her research a particular authority as she moves between two of the dominant cultures of Canada: French and English. This research is based on placing Michel Tremblay in the context of English-Canadian alternative theatre of the 1970s. After it was established in Toronto, the movement spread across the country like a furious wildfire, destroying completely the dominant

traditional values and practices which greatly hindered the progress of Canadian theatre. The plays *Les Belles-Soeurs* and *Hosanna* are selected for the purpose of examining the scandalous features of the new movement. Upon examination, the study confirms the validity of its leading hypotheses, namely, that of the alternative theatre representing a radical shift in the development of Canadian drama, and that of Tremblay, whose works are shown as absolutely crucial in establishing the Canadian theatre's identity, being rightly considered one of the most important playwrights in the history of the whole country.

"Checking In": Overcoming Mind/body Dissociation in the Role of Germaine in Michel Tremblay's Les Belles Soeurs

The present research and exploration has been an attempt to overcome my past tendency to dissociate or "check out" in my work in the role of Germaine Lauzon in Michel Tremblay's Les Belles Soeurs. By undergoing a series of Roling sessions, in addition to focusing on ways

I have managed to stay "checked in" in the past I have put together a process that will be much more conducive to staying present in my body. After consulting reviews of past productions it seemed that the most important challenge in portraying Germaine is to make her a sympathetic heroine. The following is an overview of my research conducted prior to the rehearsal process on mind/body connection in regard to my artistic challenge, an examination of Michel Tremblay's life and work, and an exploration of various aspects of the women in Les Belles Soeurs. I feel that this research prepared me well to go into a process in which I feel I have met the goals I set out for myself: in performance I stayed present in my body and the result was a Germaine that was able to

be empathized with.
