The Walcheren Campaign was an unsuccessful British expedition to the Netherlands in 1809 intended to open another front in the Austrian Empire's struggle with France during the War of the Fifth Coalition. Sir John Pitt, 2nd Earl of Chatham, was the commander of the expedition. with the missions of capturing Flushing and Antwerp in the Netherlands and enabling navigation of the Scheldt River.

Whatever the true cause, the Walcheren expedition was a disaster. With a large land force and overwhelming naval strength, the British achieved only a very limited success against French warships and dockyards. The French admitted to suffering financial losses of £2,000,000 but the expedition had cost the British at least £8,000,000.

Without a doubt, the worse expedition of the Napoleonic Wars was the British landing in the Low Countries in 1809. The British hope to achieve two goals: to assist the Austrians, who had gone to war against the French and to destroy the French fleet thought to be in Flushing. The British force, of over 39,000 men began to land in Walcheren on 30 July.

The British Expeditionary Force to Walcheren: 1809

The Walcheren Expedition, 1809 In July 1809, an amphibious British force of 40,000 men and over 600 naval vessels was sent to the Scheldt River in the French-controlled Kingdom of Holland. The 'Grand Expedition', as it was known (initially seriously, though later ironically), was up to that point Britain's biggest campaign during the wars with France - bigger even than the army in the Peninsula.

The first phase, July-August 1809. The campaign was dogged by bad luck from the start. The troops started embarking in mid-June, but the fleet's departure was delayed by unfavourable winds until the end of July. The element of surprise had been lost; and to make matters worse, news arrived on 23 July that Britain's Austrian allies had been defeated by Napoleon at the Battle of Wagram on 5-6 July.

During the War of the Fifth Coalition (fought between Britain and the Austrian Empire and France and Bavaria in 1809), Britain sent an expedition, consisting of 40,000 soldiers, 15,000 horses, two siege trains, and field artillery, across the North Sea to open another front in support of Austria's struggle against France.
