"Targum Isaiah 53 and the New Testament Concept of ...

The Targum DOES NOT teach that the suffering servant of Isaiah 53 is the Messiah. There is nothing in the Targum that even remotely is connected with the Christian theology about a Messiah who dies for the sins of the world. No person reading the Targum objectively, from beginning to end, would make such a contention.

The second study by Daniel Bailey examines the role of Isaiah 53 in Justin Martyr's Dialogue with Trypho. Bailey's study provides further evidence in support of Marksches' argument. Justin states that it was largely "Gentiles who believe in the suffering messiah" indicating, in Bailey's view, a historical reality.
