The development of sociological thought from the 19th century onwards prompted some fresh views on crime and criminality, and fostered the beginnings of criminology as a study of crime in society. Nietzsche noted a link between crime and creativity – in *The Birth of Tragedy* he asserted: [needs context] "The best and brightest that man can acquire he must obtain by crime".
