But when the Reverend dies in hospital, Angel lands in solitary confinement next to Lucius, a card-carrying Christian serial-killer. Angel holds out that he was justified and his lawyer's sure that a hearts-and-minds appeal will get him off at trial. But then, in a knife-edge final discussion before Lucius is sent to the electric chair, Angel extraordinarily finds that he too is turning towards the faith that he has so far shunned, thus jeopardising his own case against the born-again. This is a truth-telling, cage-rattling play about faith, justice and diminishing options in an American prison. A 2001 Edinburgh Festival and Off-Broadway hit, the play's London premieres at the Donmar Warehouse in March 2002.

A Haunted Life & Notes From The Haunted Courthouse

Haunted Dolls / Urban Legends / River Resurrections / Eternal Lights / Cursed Songs / Grave Robbers / Santeria / Possessions / Shadow Creatures / Hell Hounds / Satan / Doppelgängers / UFOs / Ghosts / Poltergeists / Vampires / Cattle Mutilations / Phantom Brides / Bold Rescues / Faith Healing / Vortices / Religious Ecstasy / Precognition / Bombs / Haunted Hotels / The Virgin Mary / Homicidal Psychopaths...these are a few of the legends my Puerto Rican family has encountered throughout the years. There, increasingly sinister events forced me to face the horrors of my past and come to terms with my place within the "Twilight Zone" of weirdness that surrounds my family - what we call The Zayas Zone.

While doing genealogy research, a college professor runs across a true example of that most wayward of American existences-the hobo-in a story of a pair of runaways who hopped the rails, departing for times and places unknown, with only their adventurous spirits to guide them. This expansive adventure portrays a classic American story, based on the author's grandfather's own tales and letters. Leaving a disastrous past behind, the hobo sets off on his own American dream.

Suzan-Lori Parks' play *In the Blood* was first staged at the Joseph Papp Public Theater, New York, in 1999. It was shortlisted for the Pulitzer Prize for Drama in 2000. Hester Smith of *Fucking A* works the only job available - back-street abortionist - in order to save for a reunion picnic with her imprisoned son. Her branded A bleeds afresh every time a patient comes to see her. *Fucking A* was first staged at the DiverseWorks Artspace in Houston, Texas, in February 2000.

White Pearl

"It's just a fun ad. Now the whole world is going crazy." In Singapore, Clearday(TM) has developed from a small start-up company to a leading international cosmetic brand in less than a year. But when a draft of the company's latest skin cream advert is leaked, the video goes viral globally for all the wrong reasons. YouTube views are in the thousands and keep climbing; anger is building on social media; and journalists are starting to cover the story. This is an international PR nightmare; the company cannot be seen to be racist, they've got to get it taken down before America wakes up. "It's on BUZZFEED. It's on BUZZFEED. We're not defending it." *White Pearl* marks writer Anchuli Felicia King's international playwriting debut. It premiered in the Jerwood Theatre Downstairs at the Royal Court Theatre, London, on 10 May 2019 in a production directed by Nana Dakin.

Played out under the bright lights of the US Open semifinals, *THE LAST MATCH* pits rising Russian star Sergei Sergeyev against American great Tim Porter in an epic showdown that follows two tennis titans through pivotal moments in their lives both on and off the court. This gripping, fast-paced story captures the intense world of competitive sports, and human rivalry, and what it means to want something—and the lengths we will go to in order to feel relevant, important, and young.
