The presence of pulmonary artery dilatation and subsequent reflex vasoconstriction; PE results in the elevation of the pulmonary vessel resistance as a consequence of not only mechanical obstruction of the capillary by the embolism, but also

due to pulmonary vasoconstriction. Pulmonary vasoconstriction can be either biochemically mediated, hypoxia induced, or reflex-induced.
